Leonard Da Vinci captured the power and emotions of the Last Supper in this famous painting. The painting was not intended as a faithful reproduction of the original scene. Although the setting and appearance of the table are from the sixteenth century, his painting still captures the moment. In a dark upper room in the first century Palestine, Jesus has just told his disciples that one of them will betray him. In the surprise of the moment, Peter draws a knife and asks John to entreat the Master for the identity of the betrayer. A salt shaker is overturned. While the disciple’s minds whirled with unanswered questions, the Master remained the calm center of their universe.

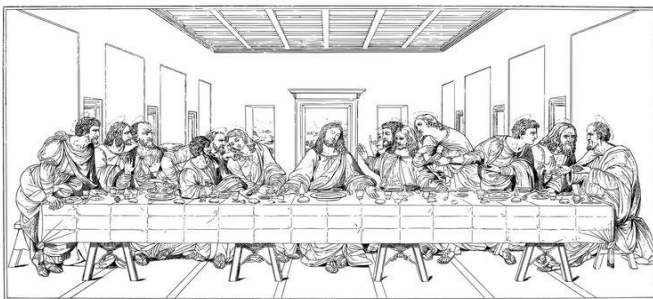
“Were You There”
